St. Patrick's Day Myth

Was St. Patrick Irish?

Many assume that St. Patrick is of Irish decent; however he is not. Patrick was born Maewyn Succat, around 385 AD in Scotland to Calpurnius and his wife Conchessa who were Italians but living in Britain (they were high status Romans).

At age 16, Patrick was captured and taken to Ireland as a slave to herd and tend sheep. During his captivity, he turned to God and religious instruction, before escaping back to Britain, six years later, where he served as a missionary.

Soon, he began his studies for the priesthood. He was ordained by St. Germanus, the Bishop of Auxerre, whom he had studied under.

One night he had a dream in which the people of Ireland were calling to him "We beg you, holy youth, to come walk among us once more".

Later Patrick was ordained a Bishop and was sent to preach the Gospel in Ireland. He preached and converted thousands and began building churches all over the country over the next 40 years. The shamrock was often used to explain the Holy Trinity. He worked many miracles and wrote of his love for God.

Saint Patrick was never canonized by the Catholic Church; however was viewed as a Saint in Ireland. St. Patrick died March 17, 461 AD.

Traditional Irish Soda Bread

Ingredients

- 4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 -1 1/2 cup buttermilk

Directions

Heat oven to 425 degrees F. Brush a baking sheet with melted butter or spray with non-stick spray.



Combine dry ingredients in a deep bowl. Gradually stir in 1 cup buttermilk, beating constantly, until dough is firm enough to be gathered into a ball. If dough crumbles, add up to 1/2 cup more buttermilk, 1 tbsp at a time, until it holds together.

Place on lightly floured board and pat into an 8-inch flattened round loaf.

Place loaf on baking sheet and slash a 1/2-inch deep "X" into the top of the dough with a small, sharp knife.

Bake at 425 degrees for about 45 minutes, or until the top is golden.
