Father's Day In Italy

Unlike the United States, which celebrates Father's Day in June, Italians do it March, 19th. 'Auguri papà' is an utterance that echos everywhere during the whole day.

Italy is deeply rooted in its Catholic tradition. Thus, a lot of feasts and festivals recall a religious event and this is also the case for the celebration of Italian dads. The 19th of March which is **Saint Joseph's day,** the father of Jesus Christ. Saint Joseph is considered by the Catholic tradition as the symbol of a pious and perfect father who fulfills his assigned role within the family, but also the protector of woodworkers, poor people and orphans.

The most widespread habits of children include writing special cards, poems and nursery rhymes in order to give them to their father. Schools usually foster these activities organizing special lessons. Ties, wallets, socks and perfumes are the most common presents sons and daughters would give to their fathers.

Fathers are the pillars of a family and thus they deserve a whole day dedicated to them and to the importance they have. La famiglia, family, is very important for Italians and this is just an occasion to remember the key role fathers play in it and a good occasion to have a succulent meal.

Zeppola di San Giuseppe

This is the most famous symbol of Father's Day - St. Joseph's Day Cream Puff. The Zeppole are round to symbolize the family and are made with the same dough that's used for cream puffs. This sometimes is called Sfingi or Bigné. They can be fried or baked and are topped with either pastry cream, or in some cases, a sweetened ricotta mixture. In the region of Puglia, a dollop of chocolate crowns the zeppole. But in many other areas, including Naples, they're decorated with a sour amarena cherry that's been soaked in a sugar syrup.

Ingredients - Pastry:

- 1/2 cup (4 oz) butter
- 1 1/2 teaspoons of sugar
- 1 cup water
- 1 cup (5 oz) flour
- · 4 eggs at room temperatureIngredients

Ingredients - Filling:

- 3/3 cup (200 ml) milk at room temperature
- · 2 egg yolks
- 1/2 cup plus 1 tbsp (5 oz) sugar
- · 2 1/4 tbsp potato starch
- · pinch of salt
- · 1 tsp vanilla extract
- · powdered sugar to sprinkle
- · Fabbri cherries (maraschino) or chocolate

Instructions:

- 1. Heat oven to 400°F.
- First prepare the pastry, by placing the butter, sugar and water in a medium sized saucepan over medium heat, until it comes to a rolling boil. Add the flour, all at once, and stir vigorously with a wooden spoon for about a minute until the mixture forms a ball.
- Remove from heat, and add an egg, beating well, until well incorporated, before adding the next. Repeat with remaining eggs, until. the batter is smooth and satiny.
- 4. Place in piping bag or spoon onto a baking mat lined with a silicone sheet or parchment paper into small puffs, about 3" apart. Pipe the upper part of the pastry so there is a small hole in the center, or make one with the back of a teaspoon.
- Bake for about 30 minutes. Turn off oven, and leave for 10 minutes, then place on cooling rack.
- 6. While the cream puffs are baking, make the filling. Place the egg yolks, sugar, potato starch, salt and vanilla into a pot and whisk together. Begin pouring in the warm milk, then turn the burner on a low heat. Continue whisking and pouring, and gradually increase the heat. Cook until the mixture thickens and is cooked (it will be a few minutes.)
- Make a hole with a skewer, into the side of the pastry and fill with pastry cream using a piping bag. Pipe more filling into the indentation on top and dust with powdered sugar.
- 8. Top with a cherry, or whatever you want to use. Repeat with remaining pastries. Source: www.christinascucina.com
