## Cheese Making: Quick Ricotta

For those of you that missed a great presentation by our very own member, Bobbie Giarratana, about cheese making, here is a recipe to share:

#### You will need:

A gallon of any type of milk

(just not "ultra pasteurized")

½ cup of white vinegar or lemon juice Butter muslin or double layer cheesecloth

Colander

Big Pot (non reactive metal like stainless steel; not cast iron or copper)

Big Bowl

#### Directions:

Heat milk gently, stirring often. Don't let it burn! Just before it boils, remove from heat, gently stir in vinegar or lemon juice. Stir gently two minutes. Curds and whey will separate. Let rest for five minutes.

Line a colander with muslin or cheesecloth, place over a bowl. Pour curds and whey into the colander and let drain into bowl. When mostly drained, tie corners of cloth and hang from kitchen sink about 2 hours. Salt to taste (not more than a Tablespoon – try a teaspoon at a time). If baking sweets, leave unsalted.

Keeps up to two weeks in refrigerator.
