# Recommendations to change "By-Law Language" regarding our Dues

#### **By-Law Language Changes**

- Article VII Rules of Order, page 8, under...Section IV Initiation Fees and Dues - Add to the last sentence in this section
  - ...and will be charged a penalty fee, along with the annual dues.

So the Section will read:

#### Section IV - Initiation/Fees and Dues

Initiation fees and dues shall be set annually by the Board of Directors. The Corresponding Secretary will post in the November and December newsletter that dues are expected to be paid no later than January 1st. A member will be delinquent if dues are not paid by February 1st and will be charged a penalty fee along with the annual dues.

Article VII - Rules of Order, page 8, under...Section V - Failure to Pay Dues

 Add verbiage to the first sentence

...and a penalty fee

So the Section will read:

#### Section V - Failure to Pay Dues

If a member fails to pay dues and a penalty fee by March 1st, it will be assumed that the member is no longer interested in the Club, and shall be automatically dropped from the membership. A certified written notice will be sent to the member by the Corresponding Secretary.

Be sure to join us at the August 6 Business Meeting as the membership will vote on the By-Law changes during this meeting.
