COVID-19 SCREENING/GUIDANCE LIST

In Accordance with the Guidelines of Alameda County

	<p>1) You must show proof of vaccination upon entering.</p>
	<p>2) Your temperature will be taken upon entering.</p>
	<p>3) A mask or face covering your nose and mouth is required to enter the facility. <i>You may remove your mask when actively eating or drinking.</i></p>
	<p>4) Avoid entering...:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. If you currently have a cough, fever, or flu-like symptoms. b. If you have been in close contact/exposed with a person who has a possible/confirmed case of COVID-19, within the last 5 days. c. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, within the last 5 days.
	<p>5) Maintain a 6' distance from one another unless in your group. <i>Avoid close contact with other members unless permission requested and given.</i></p>

To help ensure the safety of our members, kitchen and volunteer wait staff will wear a mask or face covering to cover their nose and mouths at all times, unless actively eating or drinking. In addition, they have shown proof of vaccines and temperature taken at each event. We will be following the guidelines for the protocols provided by Alameda County.
